## Using an Ontario Driver's Summary and VINShield.ca to Determine if a Customer Has Previously Exported a Vehicle

How-to guide:

- 1. Obtain and print a photocopy of the customer's driver's license
- 2. Write on a blank part of the photocopy "Driver's Summary"
- 3. Take the photocopy down to your local Service Ontario (find your nearest location)
- 4. Provide it to them and state you would like a Driver's Summary for this customer (the driver's summary is different than a driver's abstract, it will list all previously and currently registered vehicles attached to the driver's license)
- 5. Pay the \$12 fee and you will be given results similar to the following:
